A Personal Decision

For some donor families, writing to recipients about themselves and their loved one can help in their grieving process.



The Lions Eye Bank of the Northeast works with recipients of cornea transplants. To maintain confidentiality, we will be happy to facilitate the communication between you and the cornea recipient.

Some Information you may want to include:

Provide General Information

- Your loved one's first name only
- Occupation
- Hobbies interests.
- Your family situation such as marital status, any children, or grandchildren
- If you are Interested in meeting recipient

Things to keep in mind:

The beliefs of the recipient family are unknown. Please consider this before making religious comments. Do not revel your address, city, phone number, e-mail address, or the name of hospital.

Will I hear from the transplant recipient?

You may or may not. Some transplant recipients have said that they are overwhelmed with emotion and have difficulty expressing their gratitude in words. Others may take months or even years before they feel comfortable writing to their donor family.
